Charlotte Homan of Alexandria, Va.

CCW members and friends of Cornell lost a loyal supporter of the University in the December 6, 2012 passing of Charlotte Homan of Alexandria, VA. Charlotte and her husband Matt Homan '30 were active participants in CCW programs and meetings, especially in the 1970s and 1980s. Matt served on the Club's Board of Directors for a number of years and was the Club's historian and parliamentarian. In 1989 he was recognized for his years of service to the Club and Cornell in his receipt of the Bondareff award. Matt died in 1994.

Charlotte is survived by her daughters Judith and Joyce and her son, Frank, a 1962 graduate of Cornell.
