Message from CCW President

Dear CCW Members, Cornellians and Friends,

It has been an unprecedented month as Cornell, like many institutions, has responded to the rapidly evolving coronavirus pandemic. Our Big Red community is thinking about you, and we are here to help. I wanted to let you know that we are committed to the safety of our community. Out of an abundance of caution in the spirit of being good corporate citizens heeding the requests of elected leaders and respectful to the dynamic populations within our community, given the declaration of national and state emergencies and the most recent guidance, we are now working to cancel or postpone CCW events through April 15th. In addition to event cancellations and postponements, we are holding off on announcing the new events we had planned for April. You should know that we are also exploring methods of virtual programming, are creating a webpage with virtual events and will share details as they are finalized. We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience. We know that these recent developments are disruptive and disappointing. We appreciate your understanding and will be in touch as further information and guidance becomes available.
