Meet the 2021 CCW Scholarship Recipients

The Cornell Club of Washington Scholarship program enables alumni and friends an opportunity to help students financially attend Cornell. Due to the generous donations of DC-area alumni, CCW funds several scholarships for local students who attend Cornell. The scholarships help students defray the "self-help" portion of their financial aid packages and are awarded to students based upon their academic achievements, service commitment, and contributions to Cornell life. This year, two of the five scholarships were available to award to current students.

The Scholarship Committee selected Shihao Cao '23 as the recipient of the Howard S. Epstein Cornell Club of Washington Federation Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship honors the late Howard Epstein '58, Law '61, a former President of the CCW and the Cornell Federation.

The Scholarship Committee also selected Sophie Rabinowicz '21 as the recipient of the Kiplinger Cornell Club of Washington Federation Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship honors the late Austin Kiplinger '39, chairman emeritus of the Cornell University Board of Trustees.



Shihao is a sophomore in the College of Engineering. He grew up in Virginia and attended Thomas Jefferson High School. While in high school, Shihao lettered in wrestling and founded the Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Team.

At Cornell, Shihao is majoring in Computer Science. He interned at SpaceX as a Vehicle Engineering intern this summer. Shihao is the Build Events Director for Cornell Science Olympiad and a Peer Mentor for the Association of Computer Science Undergraduates as well as the Cornell Undergraduate Research Board.

Sophie is a senior in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences. She grew up in Maryland and attended Thomas Wootton High School. In high school, Sophie worked at Kicks Karate, eventually earning a black belt (she is now a second degree black belt in Tae Kwon Do) and volunteered at Good Choice Riding Center, a horse-back riding program.

At Cornell, Sophie is double majoring in Animal Science and Environment & Sustainability. She conducted avian research this summer and continues to work at the Cornell Museum of Vertebrates. Sophie transferred to Cornell as a sophomore and has since won the Cornell University Hatch Grant and Cornell Lab of Ornithology Experimental grant.
